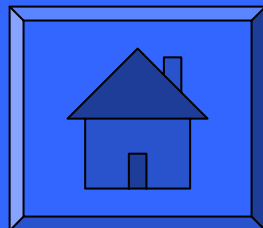

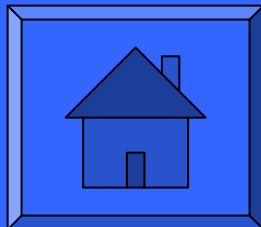

teacher training?



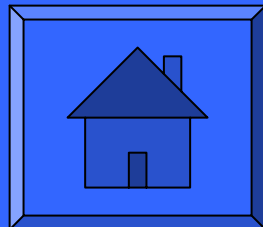

What is October 1st?



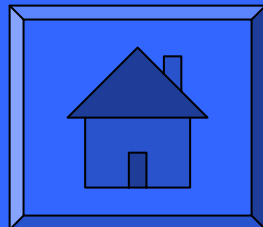

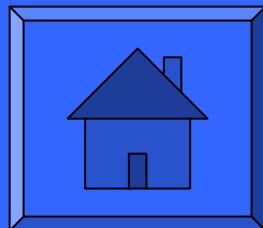

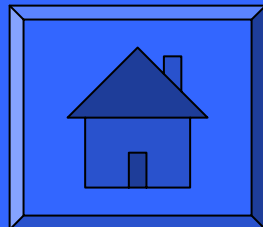

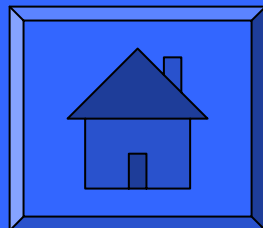

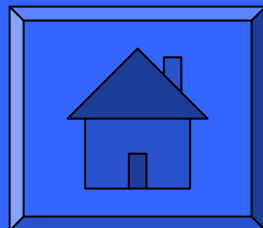

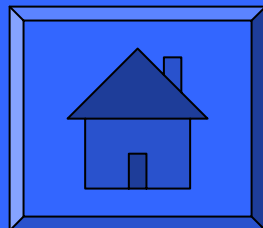
A place where nutrition

Network website?



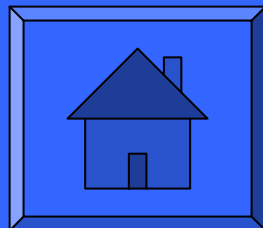
A recently established form of

listserv?



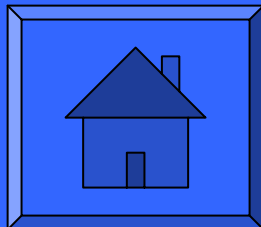
A great source of health information

What is the Health Education Resource Collection (HERC)?



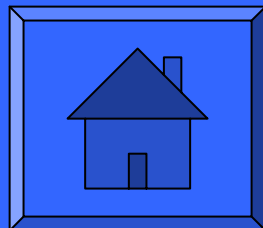

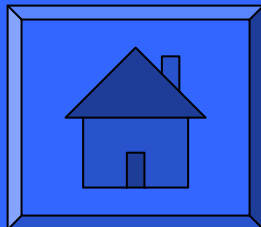
Individuals employed by the

Who are the UMCE (Cooperative Extension) Nutrition Aides?



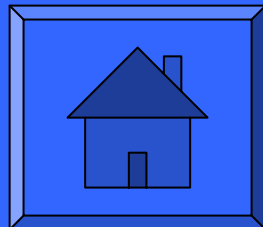
The MNN funding source that requires documentation of time and money spent on nutrition education

(USDA)?



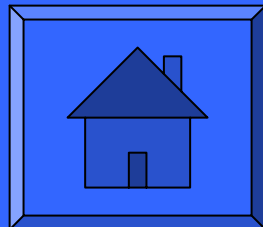
Soil, worms, and seeds are

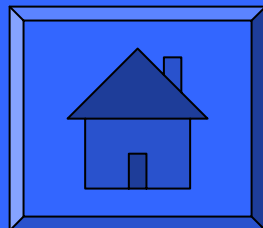
Teachers must sign this before

the Time Sheet)?



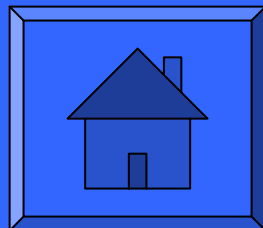
Two well known sources of

What are the Dietary Guidelines for Americans and MyPyramid?



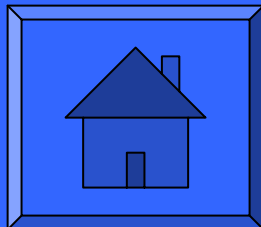
Original receipts, invoices that show payment has been made, and credit card statements

What are acceptable proofs of purchase?



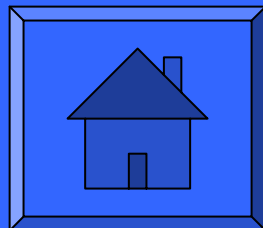
Besides teachers, these

Who are school nurses?



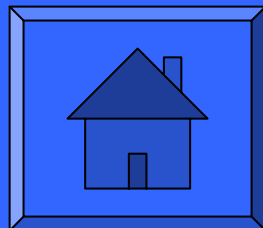
Program participants may apply for

What is a School-wide Community Nutrition Event?



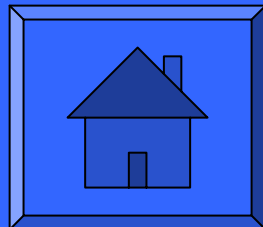
School personnel who work directly with Maine-ly Nutrition classroom teachers- they cannot sign onto the program but can attend the free training
